Statewide Code

Sec. 12802 & 12803: Authorization of local health departments for conventional and alternative systems/ education and training requirements

Sec. 12804 & 12805: Permitting conventional and alternative systems

Sec. 12808: Technical Advisory Committee Generally.

Sec. 12806 & 12808: DEQ and Technical Advisory Committee Control over Alternative Systems

Sec. 12809: Promulgation of Rules – creation of minimum standards for siting, design and inspection; Technical Advisory Role in promulgating rules. (Consideration of the 3-year rule making timeframe, sections immediately effective, and sections effective January 1, 2020.)

Sec 12810: Septic Tank Assessments; Responsibilities and authority of Septage Waste Haulers; Required for conventional systems every 10 years.

Sec 12811: System Evaluation; Conditions/Triggers of this type of evaluation

Sec. 12810 & 12811: Collection of Administrative Fees Generally

Sec 12812: Qualified Inspectors; Effective date of January 1, 2020 and dependent on establishment of the 'Statewide Code' (Rules)

Sec. 12806, 12812 & 12813: DEQ required to maintain list of registered inspectors, database of assessments/evaluations, and registered Alternative, proprietary and nonproprietary products

- Sec 12814:** Contracting with authorized local health to do work of non-authorized departments.
- Sec 12815:** Fund; Sources and authorized expenditures
- Sec 12816:** Preemption and Sunset of Point-of-Sale programs (Also consider Sec. 12803(2) – removing local regulation/guidance for alternative systems)
- Sec 12817:** Exclusive Jurisdiction over regulation, permitting and inspection
- Sec 12818:** Penalties; Fines and imprisonment
