# Organization and Function of the <u>Michigan Manual for Public Health Leaders</u> (Proposed)

- 1. The *Manual* is designed to be a resource for local public health leaders, but will be available (and useful) to other public health partners across the state.
- 2. The *Manual* would be open to the public. Any content to be shielded should be under a MALPH Board/Forum page that is password protected.
- 3. We will take advantage of links, where possible, so that when content is updated, the *Manual* will link to the latest version. (We'll likely need to check links periodically and encourage content providers to inform MALPH if links change.)
- 4. The Manual will be designed, populated and maintained by MALPH personnel.
- 5. We will depend on Forums and State Departments to vet materials they propose to include in the *Manual*.
- 6. We want to avoid duplicating materials that are posted on Board/Forum pages, unless the content is of benefit to the general public.
