Verbal Presentations

Presentations will be strictly limited to 15 minutes, followed by a 5-minute question and answer period.

Instructions for Submission:

Please provide the following information in the Abstract Submission Form on the link below.

- Authors and affiliations
- Abstract of the presentation, including: title, introduction, materials/methods, results, and discussion. Please limit the total text in this section to 250 words.
- Presenting author information: name, phone number, email address, student or non-student, credentials, employer, mailing address, job title, and biographical sketch
- Preferred method of presentation: verbal, poster, or no preference. *The review committee will accommodate these preferences as much as possible, but in some cases may request alternative presentation methods.*
- Topic category of abstract
