Proposed Sanitary Code: MALEHA is waiting to see if any revisions to HB 5752 and 5753 related to our concerns. At this time, MALEHA is still opposing the bills as written.

Rhonda Oyer, Solid Waste Section, Waste Management & Radiological Protection Division. Provided a brief update on the Medical Waste Inspection Program at our May MALEHA meeting. At this time, law revisions would not be introduced in 2018, but they are hopeful to try and move forward in early 2019. Current draft document was shared via listserv. A stakeholder meeting is being scheduled for this summer to review the draft and consider any additional changes.
