Clinical Application

Statewide CDS to improve medical/dental coordination

- Patient-centric!
- Facilitates dental referrals, captures treatment information, and enables communication between medical and dental providers
- Built for medical, dental, and social service provider users

Meaningful Use Specialized Registry Reporting

Quality Monitoring System to allow real-time monitoring of pediatric oral health

- Certified CMS Meaningful Use Specialized Registry
- Houses population-level information on access and use of preventive oral health services across care settings

Monitoring Progress



Data collected by MiDRsM is submitted to the State of Michigan, creating a real-time, reportable data system for monitoring pediatric oral health access to services and overall dental caries rates.

User Type: 50/50 Medical and Dental users

Majority of users are support staff (MAs, RNs, administrative staff)

- Fluoride Varnish Application
- Oral Screening Findings
- Dental Treatment
- Referrals submitted & completed





- ▲ MiDR's dental search leverages




Dental Office Receives Referral

Update Referral Status



- ▲ Dental clinics can now update the status of the referral to notify the physician that they have received the referral and are reaching out to the family.
- A Referrals are updated as 'seen' automatically when a dental user searches for that referral.
