


Sustaining Community-Based Immunization Actions

- □3-Year Project with generous support from the Michigan Health Endowment Fund of \$1.9 million
- □ Purpose: To improve the health of Michigan's children(ages 0-18) and Seniors (ages 65 and older) by developing and piloting a framework for sustaining high levels of recommended vaccinations.
- ☐ Two pilot regions Urban and Rural Regions 1 and 5
