Livingston County Releases “Road to Community Health” Volume 9: Domestic Violence & Volume 10: Violent Crimes

HOWELL, Michigan. - (May 30, 2018) The Livingston County Health Department (LCHD) completed the 2014 Community Health Status Assessment in June of 2015. The full publication is available at www.lchd.org, but in order to best describe and disseminate the findings LCHD is partnering with the Southeastern Michigan Health Association to bring you an informational series, “Livingston County’s Road to Community Health.” This series will break down the results of the 2014 Community Health Status Assessment into bite-sized portions so that our community can focus on the implications of one health issue or group of related issues at a time. **Volume 10 (attached) highlights that the number of domestic violence and abuse offenses in Livingston County have increased over the last decade, and volume 11 (attached) presents a snapshot of four categories of violent crimes in Livingston County as compared to the state and nation.**
